We do not need a computer but we do need to spend the time asking what God wants before we launch out with our long lists, spitting out our agenda and thinking that we have done all right.

Praying God's Kingdom to come is praying what God wants to see happen in your life, your family, your church family, your world.

Whatever God wants to see happen in your life and world would be far better than whatever we could think up.

Pray the Lord's Prayer out loud. Seek God about His Kingdom will for your life, your family, your church and the issues that you are concerned about. Be still. Ask God for His will. Have a pen and paper to write down the thoughts that "pop" into your mind as the Holy Spirit brings to your mind the thoughts of God.
